Amendment Statement of Principles concerning

No. 40 of 2010

for the purposes of the

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Statement of Principles concerning depressive disorder No. 40 of 2010.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning depressive disorder Instrument No. 27 of 2008 by:
 - (A) Inserting a new factor "(a)(xiii)" immediately following factor "(a)(xii)" in clause 6 as follows:
 - "(a)(xiii) being the victim of severe childhood abuse before the clinical onset of depressive disorder; or"; and
 - (B) Inserting a new definition for "severe childhood abuse" in clause 9 as follows:

"severe childhood abuse" means:

- (a) serious physical, emotional, psychological or sexual harm whilst a child aged under 16 years; or
- (b) neglect involving a serious failure to provide the necessities for health, physical and emotional development, or wellbeing whilst a child aged under 16 years;

where such serious harm or neglect has been perpetrated by a parent, a care provider, an adult who works with or around that child, or any other adult in contact with that child;'.

- 3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 27 of 2008, section 120A of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act* 1986 and section 338 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act* 2004 apply.
- 4. The amendments made by this instrument take effect from 12 May 2010.
