

Amendment Statement of Principles  
concerning

**VASCULAR DEMENTIA**

**No. 63 of 2006**

for the purposes of the

*Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*  
and

*Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004*

1. This Instrument may be cited as Statement of Principles concerning vascular dementia No. 63 of 2006.
2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(2) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning vascular dementia No. 21 of 2006 by:
  - (A) deleting the definition for “**cerebrovascular disease**” in clause 9 and replacing it with the following definition:

“**cerebrovascular disease**” means any abnormality of the brain resulting from a pathologic process of the cerebral blood vessels or decreased blood flow to the brain, including cerebral ischaemia, intracerebral haemorrhage or cerebral infarction;’
3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 21 of 2006, section 120A of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* and section 338 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004* apply.
4. The amendment made by this instrument takes effect from 8 November 2006.
