## NOTICE OF INVESTIGATION

## Section 196G of the

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986

The Repatriation Medical Authority (the Authority) gives notice under section 196G of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* (the VEA) that as there are grounds for such a review it intends to carry out an investigation in respect of the following:

- a. the definition of hypertension and the ICD coding;
- b. **alcohol consumption** as a factor in hypertension; and
- c. **dioxin exposure** and **dioxin contaminated herbicide exposure** as a factor/s in hypertension.

This investigation will be carried out in the context of Statements of Principles concerning **hypertension** (Instrument Nos. 35 and 36 of 2003, as amended by instrument Nos. 3 and 4 of 2004).

The Authority invites the following persons and organisations to make written submissions to the Authority in respect of the investigation:

- any person eligible to make a claim for pension under Part II or Part IV of the Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986;
- any person eligible to make a claim for compensation under section 319 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act* 2004 (the MRCA);
- an organisation representing veterans, Australian mariners, members of the Forces, members of the Peacekeeping Forces, members within the meaning of the MRCA, or their dependants;
- the Repatriation Commission or the Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Commission; and
- any person having expertise in a field relevant to the investigation.

The Repatriation Medical Authority will hold its first meeting for the purposes of the investigation on **10 December 2007.**
