## NOTICE OF INVESTIGATION

## Section 196G of the

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986

The Repatriation Medical Authority (the Authority) gives notice under section 196G of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* ['the VEA'] that it intends to carry out an investigation under section 196B(4) of the VEA to find out whether a Statement of Principles may be determined in respect of **substance induced mood disorder**.

The Authority invites the following persons and organisations to make written submissions to the Authority in respect of the investigation:

- any person eligible to make a claim for pension under Part II or Part IV of the Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986;
- any person eligible to make a claim for compensation under section 319 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act* 2004 ['the MRCA'];
- an organisation representing veterans, Australian mariners, members of the Forces, members of the Peacekeeping Forces, members within the meaning of the MRCA, or their dependants;
- the Repatriation Commission or the Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Commission; and
- any person having expertise in a field relevant to the investigation.

The Authority will hold its first meeting for the purposes of this investigation on 4 June 2007.

Under the VEA, the Authority is required to find out whether there is information available about how **substance induced mood disorder** may be suffered or contracted, or death from **substance induced mood disorder** or death from **substance induced mood disorder** or death from **substance induced mood disorder** may be war-caused, defence-caused, a service injury, a service disease or a service death.
