## Statement of Principles

## HORSESHOE KIDNEY

ICD CODE: 753.3

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 subsection 196B(2)

- 1. Being of the view that there is sound medical-scientific evidence that indicates that horseshoe kidney and death from horseshoe kidney can be related to operational service rendered by veterans, peacekeeping service rendered by members of Peacekeeping forces and hazardous service rendered by members of the Forces, the Repatriation Medical Authority determines, under subsection 196B(2) of the *Veterans'* Entitlements Act 1986, that the factors that must as a minimum exist before it can be said that a reasonable hypothesis has been raised connecting horseshoe kidney or death from horseshoe kidney with the circumstances of that service, are:
  - (a) suffering physical trauma before the clinical worsening of horseshoe kidney; or
  - (b) inability to obtain appropriate clinical management for the horseshoe kidney.
- 2. Subject to clause 3 (below) at least one of the factors set out in paragraphs **1(a) to 1(b)** must be related to any service rendered by a person.
- 3. The factors set out in paragraphs **1(a)** and **1(b)** apply only where:
  - (a) the person's **horseshoe kidney** was suffered prior to a period, or part of a period, of service to which the factor is related; and

- (b) the relationship suggested between the **horseshoe kidney** and the particular service of a person is a relationship set out in paragraph 8(1)(e), 9(1)(e), 70(5)(d), or 70(5A)(d) of the Act.
- 4. For the purposes of this Statement of Principles:

"horseshoe kidney" means a congenital abnormality of the kidneys whereby the lower poles of normally positioned kidneys are fused, attracting ICD code 753.3;

"ICD code" means a number assigned to a particular kind of injury or disease in the tenth edition of the *International Classification of Diseases* 9th Revision, effective date of 1 October 1993, copyrighted by the US Commission on Professional and Hospital Activities, and having the Library of Congress number 77-94472;

"physical trauma" means an injury to the body caused by the force of an extraneous physical or mechanical agent.
