# **Statement of Principles**

### concerning

## **ALBINISM**

#### **ICD CODE: 270.2**

## Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 subsection 196B(3)

- 1. Being of the view that, on the sound medical-scientific evidence available to the Repatriation Medical Authority, it is more probable than not that **albinism and death from albinism** can be related to eligible war service (other than operational service) rendered by veterans and defence service (other than hazardous service) rendered by members of the Forces, the Repatriation Medical Authority determines, under subsection 196B(3) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, that the factors that must exist before it can be said that, on the balance of probabilities, **albinism or death from albinism** is connected with the circumstances of that service, are:
  - (a) being exposed to ultra violet radiation before the clinical worsening of albinism; or
  - (b) the inability to obtain appropriate clinical management for albinism.
- Subject to clause 3 (below) at least one of the factors set out in paragraphs
  1(a) to (b) must be related to any service rendered by a person.
- 3. The factors set out in paragraphs **1(a) to 1(b)** apply only where:
  - (a) the person's **albinism** was contracted prior to a period, or part of a period, of service to which the factor is related; and

- (b) the relationship suggested between the **albinism** and the particular service of a person is a relationship set out in paragraph 8(1)(e), 9(1)(e) or 70(5)(d) of the Act.
- 4. For the purposes of this Statement of Principles:

**"albinism"** means the term used for a number of inborn aminoacidopathies affecting the pigmant cell (melanocyte) system of the eye and skin and causing hypomelanosis or amelanosis of the eye, skin and hair and attracting ICD code 270.2;

**"ICD code"** means a number assigned to a particular kind of injury or disease in the tenth edition of the *International Classification of Diseases* 9th Revision, effective date of 1 October 1993, copyrighted by the US Commission on Professional and Hospital Activities, and having the Library of Congress number 77-94472.
