## **Statement of Principles**

#### concerning

## **VON WILLEBRAND'S DISEASE**

#### **ICD CODE: 286.4**

### Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 subsection 196B(3)

- 1. Being of the view that, on the sound medical-scientific evidence available to the Repatriation Medical Authority, it is more probable than not that **von Willebrand's disease and death from von Willebrand's disease** can be related to eligible war service (other than operational service) rendered by veterans and defence service (other than hazardous service) rendered by members of the Forces, the Repatriation Medical Authority determines, under subsection 196B(3) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, that the factors that must exist before it can be said that, on the balance of probabilities, **von Willebrand's disease or death from von Willebrand's disease** is connected with the circumstances of that service, are:
  - (a) suffering physical trauma before the clinical worsening of von Willebrand's disease; or
  - (b) treatment with drugs that interfere with platelet function before the clinical worsening of von Willebrand's disease; or
  - (c) inability to obtain appropriate clinical management for von Willebrand's disease.
- 2. Subject to clause 3 (below) at least one of the factors set out in paragraphs **1(a) to (c)** must be related to any service rendered by a person.

- 3. The factors set out in paragraphs **1(a) to 1(c)** apply only where:
  - (a) the person's **von Willebrand's disease** was contracted prior to a period, or part of a period, of service to which the factor is related; and
  - (b) the relationship suggested between the **von Willebrand's disease** and the particular service of a person is a relationship set out in paragraph 8(1)(e), 9(1)(e) or 70(5)(d) of the Act.
- 4. For the purposes of this Statement of Principles:

**"ICD code"** means a number assigned to a particular kind of injury or disease in the tenth edition of the *International Classification of Diseases* 9th Revision, effective date of 1 October 1993, copyrighted by the US Commission on Professional and Hospital Activities, and having the Library of Congress number 77-94472;

"physical trauma" means an injury to the body caused by the force of an extraneous physical or mechanical agent;

**"von Willebrand's disease"** means an inherited coagulation/bleeding disorder based on a heterogeneous multimeric plasma glycoprotein and which condition attracts an ICD code of 286.4
