## Statement of Principles

concerning

## **TENSION HEADACHE**

**ICD CODE: 307.81** 

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 subsection 196B(3)

- 1. Being of the view that on the sound medical-scientific evidence available to the Repatriation Medical Authority, it is more probable than not that **tension headache** and **death from tension headache** can be related to eligible war service (other than operational service) rendered by veterans and defence service (other than hazardous service) rendered by members of the Forces, the Repatriation Medical Authority determines, under subsection 196B(3) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* (the Act), that the factor that must exist before it can be said that, on the balance of probabilities, **tension headache** or **death from tension headache** is connected with the circumstances of that service, is:
  - (a) inability to obtain appropriate clinical management for the tension headache.
- 2. Subject to clause 3 (below) the factor set out in paragraph **1(a)** must be related to any service rendered by a person.
- 3. The factor set out in paragraph **1(a)** applies only where:

- (a) the person's **tension headache** developed before a period, or part of a period, of service to which the factor is related; and
- (b) the relationship suggested between the **tension headache** and the particular service of a person is a relationship set out in paragraph 8(1)(e), 9(1)(e) or 70(5)(d) of the Act.
- 4. For the purposes of this Statement of Principles:

"ICD code" means a number assigned to a particular kind of injury or disease in the tenth edition of the *International Classification of Diseases* 9th Revision, effective date of 1 October 1993, copyrighted by the US Commission on Professional and Hospital Activities, and having the Library of Congress number 77-94472;

"tension headache" also known as muscle contraction headache or stress headache, means an ill-defined episodic or chronic headache condition, attracting ICD code 307.81.
