The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(3) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* (the Act), Instrument No.98 of 1995, (Statement of Principles concerning malignant melanoma of the skin), by:

- 1. omitting the definition of "ICD code" from paragraph 4, and replacing it with the following:
 - "ICD code' means a number assigned to a particular kind of injury or disease in the Australian Version of The International Classification of Diseases, 9th revision, Clinical Modification (ICD-9-CM), effective date of 1 July 1996, copyrighted by the National Coding Centre, Faculty of Health Sciences, University of Sydney, NSW, and having ISBN 0 642 24447 2;";
- 2. omitting the definition of "sunburn" from paragraph 4, and replacing it with the following:
 - "sunburn' means an inflammatory condition of the skin, characterised by 48 hours or more of painful erythema, or blistering sunburn.";
