Amendment of Statement of Principles concerning

ANGLE-CLOSURE GLAUCOMA No. 25 of 2006

for the purposes of the

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(2) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Instrument No. 15 of 1999, by:
 - A. in clause 8, deleting the definition of "**significant trauma to the affected eye**" and inserting in its place the following:
 - "'significant trauma to the affected eye' means penetrating, blunt, chemical or radiation injury involving the affected eye that results in intraocular inflammation, intraocular bleeding or other intraocular tissue disruption;"
- 2. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 15 of 1999, section 120A of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* and section 338 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004* apply.
- 3. The amendment made by this instrument takes effect from 10 May 2006.
