Amendment Statement of Principles

concerning

OSTEOPOROSIS No. 62 of 2006

for the purposes of the

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Statement of Principles concerning osteoporosis No. 62 of 2006.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(3) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning osteoporosis No. 30 of 2006 by:
 - (A) deleting the words "more than 7.5 grams per day of Vitamin A" in Clause 6 factors (q) and (zk), and replacing them with the words "at least 7.5 milligrams per day of Vitamin A"; and
 - (B) deleting the word "ankylosis" in Clause 6 factors (g) and (za), and replacing it with the word "ankylosing".
- 3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Statement of Principles concerning osteoporosis No. 30 of 2006, section 120B of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* and section 339 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004* apply.
- 4. The amendments made by this instrument take effect from 8 November 2006.
