## Amendment Statement of Principles concerning

## INTERVERTEBRAL DISC PROLAPSE No. 81 of 2008

for the purposes of the

## Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Statement of Principles concerning intervertebral disc prolapse No. 81 of 2008.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning intervertebral disc prolapse No. 40 of 2007 by:
  - (A) Replacing existing factor "(d)" in clause 6 with the following:
    - "(d) driving a motor vehicle for an average of at least 30 hours per week, for a period of at least two years within the ten years before the clinical onset of intervertebral disc prolapse; or"; and
  - (B) Replacing existing factor "(k)" in clause 6 with the following:
    - "(k) driving a motor vehicle for an average of at least 30 hours per week, for a period of at least two years within the ten years before the clinical worsening of intervertebral disc prolapse; or"; and
  - (C) Inserting a new factor "(da)" immediately following factor "(d)" in clause 6 as follows:

- "(da) flying a motorised aircraft for a cumulative total of at least 5000 hours within the ten years before the clinical onset of intervertebral disc prolapse; or"; and
- (D) Inserting a new factor "(ka)" immediately following factor "(k)" in clause 6 as follows:
  - "(ka) flying a motorised aircraft for a cumulative total of at least 5000 hours within the ten years before the clinical worsening of intervertebral disc prolapse; or"; and
- (E) Replacing the definition of "high performance aircraft" in clause 9 with the following:

"high performance aircraft" means an aircraft capable of routinely sustaining a positive G force of four or more;'.

- 3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 40 of 2007, section 120B of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act* 1986 and section 339 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act* 2004 apply.
- 4. The amendment made by this instrument takes effect from 5 November 2008.
