Amendment Statement of Principles concerning

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Statement of Principles concerning diabetes mellitus No. 10 of 2008.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning diabetes mellitus Instrument No. 12 of 2004 by:
 - (A) deleting factors (a) and (u) in clause 5 concerning 'rubella virus or Coxsackie B virus'; and
 - (B) deleting the definitions of "rubella virus" and "Coxsackie B virus" in clause 8.
- 3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 12 of 2004, section 120B of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act* 1986 and section 339 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act* 2004 apply.
- 4. The amendment made by this instrument takes effect from 9 January 2008.
