## Amendment Statement of Principles concerning

## LUMBAR SPONDYLOSIS No. 78 of 2008

for the purposes of the

## Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Statement of Principles concerning lumbar spondylosis No. 78 of 2008.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning lumbar spondylosis No. 37 of 2005 by:
  - (A) Inserting a new factor "(ja)" immediately following factor "(j)" in clause 6 as follows:
    - "(ja) flying a motorised aircraft for a cumulative total of at least 2500 hours within the ten years before the clinical onset of lumbar spondylosis; or"; and
  - (B) Inserting a new factor "(sa)" immediately following factor "(s)" in clause 6 as follows:
    - "(sa) flying a motorised aircraft for a cumulative total of at least 2500 hours within the ten years before the clinical worsening of lumbar spondylosis; or".
- 3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 37 of 2005, section 120A of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act* 1986 and section 338 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act* 2004 apply.
