## Amendment Statement of Principles concerning

## CUT, STAB, ABRASION AND LACERATION No. 49 of 2008

for the purposes of the

## Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Statement of Principles concerning cut, stab, abrasion and laceration No. 49 of 2008.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(3) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning cut, stab, abrasion and laceration No. 4 of 2008 by:
  - A. Inserting the word "direct" after the word "having" in factor "(a)" in clause 6; and
  - B. Inserting the word "the" after the word "of" in factor "(a)" in clause 6.
- 3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 4 of 2008, section 120B of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act* 1986 and section 339 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act* 2004 apply.
- 4. The amendment made by this instrument takes effect from 2 July 2008.
