 - (A) Deleting the definition of "electrical injury" from clause 9.
- 3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 40 of 2008, section 120B of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* and section 339 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004* apply.
- 4. The amendment made by this instrument takes effect from 1 July 2009.
