Amendment Statement of Principles
concerning

MALIGNANT NEOPLASM OF THE BREAST

No. 53 of 2011

for the purposes of the

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986
and
Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

1. This Instrument may be cited as Statement of Principles concerning malignant neoplasm of the breast No. 53 of 2011.
2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning malignant neoplasm of the breast Instrument No. 27 of 2006 by:
 - (A) Replacing existing factor "(a)" in clause 6 with the following:

"(a) having received a cumulative equivalent dose of at least 0.1 sievert of ionising radiation to the breast at least five years before the clinical onset of malignant neoplasm of the breast; or";
 - (B) Deleting existing factors "(b)" and "(c)" from clause 6;
 - (C) Re-numbering existing factors "(d)" to "(l)" in clause 6 as "(b)" to "(j)" respectively;
 - (D) Replacing "6(l)" in clause 7 with "6(j)";
 - (E) Replacing the existing definition of "cumulative equivalent dose" in clause 9 with the following:
