- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Statement of Principles concerning anxiety disorder No. 15 of 2011.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning anxiety disorder Instrument No. 101 of 2007, as amended by Instrument No. 42 of 2010, by:
 - A. Deleting factor "(c)(x)" in clause 6; and
 - B. Inserting a new factor "(a)(xi)" immediately following factor "(a)(x)" in clause 6 as follows:
 - "(a)(xi) being the victim of severe childhood abuse before the clinical onset of anxiety disorder; or".
- 3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 101 of 2007, as amended by Instrument No. 42 of 2010, section 120A of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* and section 338 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004* apply.
- 4. The amendment made by this instrument takes effect from 5 January 2011.
