

## Amendment Statement of Principles concerning

## OTITIC BAROTRAUMA No. 16 of 2017

for the purposes of the

## Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Amendment Statement of Principles concerning otitic barotrauma No. 16 of 2017.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning otitic barotrauma Instrument No. 36 of 2012, by:
  - (A) Replacing the definition of "a change in the ambient barometric pressure as specified" in clause 9 with the following:
  - "'a change in the ambient barometric pressure as specified" means a significant and rapid reduction or increase in the pressure surrounding the person, including in such circumstances as:
  - (a) ascending from a submerged craft or device or a submarine escape training facility;
  - (b) decompression or compression in a hypobaric or hyperbaric chamber;
  - (c) flying;
  - (d) sky diving;
  - (e) underwater diving;
  - (f) working in a submarine; or
  - (g) working in a pressurised chamber or tunnel;'.
- 3. The amendment made by this instrument applies to all matters to which Instrument No. 36 of 2012, section 120B of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act* 1986 and section 339 of the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act* 2004 apply.
