

Amendment Statement of Principles

concerning

LUMBAR SPONDYLOSIS

No. 68 of 2018

for the purposes of the

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Amendment Statement of Principles concerning lumbar spondylosis No. 68 of 2018.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning lumbar spondylosis Instrument No. 63 of 2014 (Federal Register of Legislation No. F2014L00930) by:
 - A. Repealing factors "(i)", "(j)", "(x)" and "(y)" in clause 6 and substituting the following:
 - "(i) lifting loads of at least 20 kilograms while bearing weight through the lumbar spine:
 - (i) to a cumulative total of at least 150 000 kilograms within any ten year period before the clinical onset of lumbar spondylosis; and
 - (ii) where the clinical onset of lumbar spondylosis occurs within the 25 years following that period; or";
 - "(j) carrying loads of at least 20 kilograms while bearing weight through the lumbar spine:
 - to a cumulative total of at least 3 800 hours within any ten year period before the clinical onset of lumbar spondylosis; and
 - (ii) where the clinical onset of lumbar spondylosis occurs within the 25 years following that period; or";

- "(x) lifting loads of at least 20 kilograms while bearing weight through the lumbar spine:
 - (i) to a cumulative total of at least 150 000 kilograms within any ten year period before the clinical worsening of lumbar spondylosis; and
 - (ii) where the clinical worsening of lumbar spondylosis occurs within the 25 years following that period; or";
- "(y) carrying loads of at least 20 kilograms while bearing weight through the lumbar spine:
 - (i) to a cumulative total of at least 3 800 hours within any ten year period before the clinical worsening of lumbar spondylosis; and
 - (ii) where the clinical worsening of lumbar spondylosis occurs within the 25 years following that period; or".
- 3. The amendments made by this instrument commence on 23 July 2018.
