

Amendment Statement of Principles

concerning

HYPERTENSION

No. 89 of 2019

for the purposes of the

Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and

Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Amendment Statement of Principles concerning hypertension No. 89 of 2019.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning hypertension Instrument No. 63 of 2013 (Federal Register of Legislation No. F2013L01652) by:
 - (A) Amending paragraph 6 by inserting new factors (pa), (pb), (ffa) and (ffb) as follows:
 - "(pa) inhaling, ingesting or having cutaneous contact with a phenoxy acid herbicide from the specified list:
 - (i) for a cumulative period of at least 1 000 hours within a consecutive period of ten years, before the clinical onset of hypertension; and
 - (ii) where the first exposure occurred at least five years before the clinical onset of hypertension; and
 - (iii) where that exposure has ceased, the clinical onset of hypertension has occurred within 25 years of cessation; or";

- "(pb) inhaling, ingesting or having cutaneous contact with a chemical agent contaminated by 2,3,7,8-tetrachlorodibenzo-para-dioxin (TCDD):
 - (i) for a cumulative period of at least 1 000 hours within a consecutive period of ten years, before the clinical onset of hypertension; and
 - (ii) where the first exposure occurred at least five years before the clinical onset of hypertension; and
 - (iii) where that exposure has ceased, the clinical onset of hypertension has occurred within 25 years of cessation; or";
- "(ffa) inhaling, ingesting or having cutaneous contact with a phenoxy acid herbicide from the specified list:
 - (i) for a cumulative period of at least 1 000 hours within a consecutive period of ten years, before the clinical worsening of hypertension; and
 - (ii) where the first exposure occurred at least five years before the clinical worsening of hypertension; and
 - (iii) where that exposure has ceased, the clinical worsening of hypertension has occurred within 25 years of cessation; or";
- "(ffb) inhaling, ingesting or having cutaneous contact with a chemical agent contaminated by 2,3,7,8-tetrachlorodibenzo-para-dioxin (TCDD):
 - (i) for a cumulative period of at least 1 000 hours within a consecutive period of ten years, before the clinical worsening of hypertension; and
 - (ii) where the first exposure occurred at least five years before the clinical worsening of hypertension; and
 - (iii) where that exposure has ceased, the clinical worsening of hypertension has occurred within 25 years of cessation; or"; and
- (B) Amending paragraph 7 by inserting the words, "including paragraphs 6(ffa) and 6(ffb)", after the phrase, "Paragraphs 6(q) to 6(gg)"; and
- (C) Amending paragraph 9 by inserting in alphabetical order the following definitions:

"inhaling, ingesting or having cutaneous contact with a chemical agent contaminated by 2,3,7,8-tetrachlorodibenzo-para-dioxin (TCDD)" means:

- (a) decanting or spraying;
- (b) cleaning or maintaining equipment used to apply;
- (c) being sprayed with;
- (d) handling or sawing timber treated with;

- (e) being in an environment shrouded in dust from timber treated with: or
- using cutting oils contaminated with; (f)

one of the following chemicals:

- 2,4,5-trichlorophenoxyacetic acid; (i)
- (ii) 2,4,5-trichlorophenoxypropionic acid;
- 2,4,5-trichlorophenol; (iii)
- 2-(2,4,5-trichlorophenoxy)-ethyl 2,2-(iv) dichloropropionionate;
- o,o-dimethyl-o-(2,4,5-trichlorophenyl)-(v) phosphorothioate;
- pentachlorophenol; (vi)
- 2,3,4,6-tetrachlorophenol; (vii)
- (viii) 2,4,6-trichlorophenol;
- 1,3,5-trichloro-2-(4-nitrophenoxy)benzene; (ix)
- 2,4-dichloro-1-(4-nitrophenoxy)benzene; or (x)
- 2,4-dichloro-1-(3-methoxy-4-nitrophenoxy)-benzene;'; (xi)
- and

"phenoxy acid herbicide from the specified list" means:

- 2,4-dichlorophenoxyacetic acid (2,4-D); or (a)
- 2,4,5-trichlorophenoxyacetic acid (2,4,5-T);'. (b)

)
