

## Amendment Statement of Principles concerning

## CERVICAL SPONDYLOSIS No. 102 of 2019

for the purposes of the

## Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986 and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004

- 1. This Instrument may be cited as Amendment Statement of Principles concerning cervical spondylosis No. 102 of 2019.
- 2. The Repatriation Medical Authority amends, under subsection 196B(8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*, Statement of Principles concerning cervical spondylosis Instrument No. 66 of 2014 (Federal Register of Legislation No. F2014L00928) by:
  - (A) Amending paragraph 6 by inserting new factors (ia) & (va) as follows:
    - "(ia) carrying a large bulky load of at least 15 kilograms positioned between the neck and shoulder to a cumulative total of at least 5 000 hours within any ten year period before the clinical onset of cervical spondylosis; or"; and
    - "(va) carrying a large bulky load of at least 15 kilograms positioned between the neck and shoulder to a cumulative total of at least 5 000 hours within any ten year period before the clinical worsening of cervical spondylosis; or".
- 3. The amendments made by this instrument commence on 18 November 2019.
